April 19, 2025 A.D

Holy Saturday

A Celebration of the Resurrection of our Lord and Remembrance of our Boly Baptism

Prayerful reflective silence is most appropriate prior to the service. Prayers for worship may be found inside the front cover of the hymnal.

*Stand

The service will begin outdoors around the fire.

*Service of Light

- P In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. C Amen.
- P Beloved in the Lord, on this most holy night, in which our Lord Jesus passed over from death to life, we are gathered here in vigil and prayer. This is the Passover of the Lord in which, by hearing His Word and celebrating his sacraments, we share in His victory over death.
- P Let us pray...one God, now and forever. C Amen.

The pastor traces the cross and the Greek letters Alpha and Omega upon it, saying:

P Christ Jesus, the same yesterday, today, & forever, the beginning & ending, the Alpha & Omega.

He traces the year upon the candle, saying:

P His are time and eternity; His are the glory and dominion, now and forever.

He puts the five wax nails into the candle, saying:

P By His wounds we have healing both now and forever. Amen

Then, lighting the candle, he says:


- **P** May the light of Christ, who is risen in glory from the dead, scatter all the darkness of our hearts & minds.
- P Let us pray...even Jesus Christ, our Lord. C Amen.

The congregation enters the sanctuary; candles are lit from the paschal candle as they pass by.

Please remain standing and face the cross as it passes.

The Paschal Candle is lowered into the water and the sign of the cross is made to show that, in Holy Baptism, a person is born of God




Service of the Word







